READ

Your child is able to memorize parts of their favorite books. If you have not already been it is a good time to start going to story time at the library. Your child will enjoy the stories, songs and interactions with other children. Keep up your reading routine at home. It is paying off.



ENGAGE

Your baby's language is growing! While reading books take time to have them point to different objects in the pictures, "Where is the bear?" Also, practice new gestures with your baby like blowing kisses or nodding their head yes.



ATTACH

Toys are beginning to be very interesting for your child at this age. Take time to play kitchen with your child. They will enjoy putting toy food on toy plates.



DISCOVER

It is time to practice naming body parts. Help your child to learn their eyes, ears, nose, mouth and hair. Your child will love discovering the names for these feature and will point them out on themselves or you!



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
